The Precious Blood of Christ 1 Peter 1:18-19

What is it that makes the blood of Christ so	_? We know that something that is precious
transcends the ordinary and brings us into the area of the	uncommon and the extraordinary.

- 1. Christ's <u>Blood</u> Is Flawlessly Precious.
 - A. There are stones that have a very high value but they are not flawless gems.
 - B. The only One who has ever been flawless is the precious <u>Son</u> of <u>God</u>. 1 John 1:7.
 - C. Christ's blood is <u>extraordinary</u>. It is of great value. It is flawless.
- 2. Christ's Blood Is Precious to Redeem.
 - A. The word "precious" refers to the value of the blood.
 - B. A death was required for Jesus' blood to be effectual. Romans 3:23.
 - C. Jesus, in His holy <u>perfection</u>, offered His precious blood to redeem. 1 Corinthians 6:19-20.
 - D. Consider how much you and I are <u>worth</u>. Matthew 16:26. (One soul is more valuable than the <u>whole</u> world.
- 3. Christ's Blood Is Precious in Heaven.

How much does the Lord regard Christ? On one occasion, the Father said, "This is My beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased, listen to Him (Matt. 17:5).

- A. "It was the will of the Father to <u>crush</u> Him" (Isa. 53:10). The KJV says "it pleased the Lord to bruise Him."
- B. The Father was pleased because He knew it was by Jesus' bruises that you and I would be healed.
- C. These bruises are not only precious to the Father but also to the whole host of heaven.
 - 1) In Revelation 4:1-6, God pulled away the veil.
 - 2) In Revelation 5:1-14, the Lamb takes the scroll.
