- B. The people were just outside, **praying** (10).
- C. The right side was reserved for **God** (11).
- D. Zechariah was troubled (12).
- E. The angel's message (13-17).
 - 1) Fear **not** (13a).
 - 2) Your prayer has been **heard** (13b).
 - 3) Great **<u>ioy</u>** resulted (14-17).

- Do you believe Zechariah understood the tremendous impact of his experience as the Angel of the Lord appeared before him?
- According to Luke 1:13-17, a description of John the Baptist as being a forerunner of Jesus is given. Think about the significance of this information in relation to the coming of Messiah.
- Think about the abundant joy this couple experienced when they realized that Elizabeth had conceived a baby. This answer to prayer was surely a gift from God. A hopeless situation was turned into HOPE!
- Look at Malachi chapter 3 and read the prediction that John would be a messenger who would go before the Messiah. Think about God's wonderful power as He fulfills all prophecy.

Application:

- When all hope seems lost, we must wait on the Lord to answer our prayers.
- The Lord's plan for every believer's life is to be blessed. All we must do is look to Him.
- Whatever problem one has in life, one must submit it to God completely and allow Him to work His power.
